Special Olympics is the world's largest sports organization for children and adults with intellectual disabilities, providing year-round training and competitions to more than 4.7 million athletes in more than 170 countries. The Special Olympics World Games, which alternate between summer and winter games, are bi-annual and are often the largest sporting event to take place in the world during that year.

Austria will host the 2017 World Winter Games, in which more than 2,600 athletes from 107 nations will compete across Alpine Skiing, Cross Country Skiing, Figure Skating, Floor Hockey, Floorball, Short Track Speed Skating, Snowboarding, Snowshoeing and Stick Shooting.
